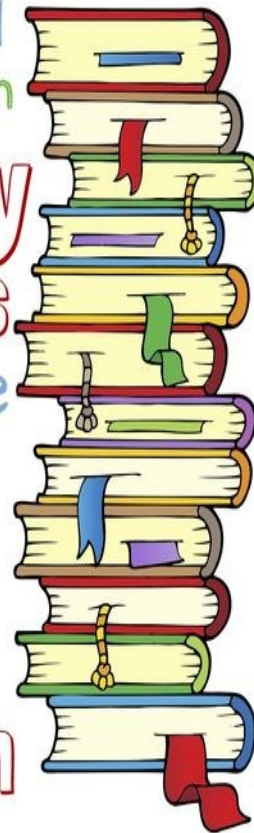
Points Lowdown
