#### MISSION MINISTRY

April and May, our church has modified the process by which we assist families through our FirstCares Ministry (Benevolence). We have been able to help families stay in their home to give more time for them to catch up with expenses. Thank you for giving and praying for this ministry and people in our community.

- April & May we helped 76 families for a total of \$61,852. Over 65% of these families had never before been assisted by FBC.
- We have had many opportunities to pray and share the gospel with these families and have helped people who have recently come from Cuba, Venezuela, and Nigeria to work.
- We were able to help one father who was laid off from work and later in the week received a call to go pick up his children due to suspected neglect/abuse of the person who had custody of them. We were able to help encourage this father in a difficult time of need.


