NEW CHILD CHECK-IN PROCEDURES BEGIN THIS WEEK AND THE RETURN OF CHILDCARE FOR THE 8:15 SERVICE

Likewise, extended session classes will return this week as well. At the 8:15 service ONLY, we'll be glad to welcome children 4 yrs old (PreK) and down in our Preschool hallway.

PRESCHOOL & CHILDREN'S MINISTRY

A NEW Step-by-Step Guide for FBC Elementary and Preschool Families, beginning SEPTEMBER 13TH:

- Enter at the Fish Tank if arriving to check in kids before early service (preschool only) and/or Sunday School. Screeners are available from 7:45-8:15 AM (preschool) and 9:00-9:30 AM (preschool and elementary). If attending early service with children, you can screen for Sunday School in the Chapel Foyer from 9:15-9:30 AM (immediately following worship).
- Stop to get a temperature check. (By checking your child in, you are affirming that your child has been symptom-free for 24 hours and free from known exposure for 14 days. Please see the posted sign for details.)
- Complete a security tag for all children 6th grade and younger.
- Parents who have been temperature checked and completed a security tag will be allowed into the preschool/children's areas and may escort their child(ren) to class.
- It would be best if only one parent entered the hallway, but we also trust you to use your best judgment. Please do not linger in the hallway or common areas. We want to limit traffic flow as much as possible to maintain a healthy and safe environment.
- As soon as Sunday School (or Music/Missions on Wednesday evenings) concludes, please return to your child's classroom with the security tag.
- Worship at 11:00am will be available in the Worship Center, Chapel, or Fellowship Hall. (The Fellowship Hall will still be set up as a family-friendly worship environment with tables and activities!) Preschool classes are not available during this service time.

After checking in your preschoolers and elementary kids in the fish tank area, you can use the elevator or stairs by the C Hall to go directly to your classroom. Please return to pick up your kids immediately following Sunday School.

STUDENTS

To protect our students and provide the safest possible environment, student's temperature will be checked at the classroom door. Students will wear masks for the duration of the class.

If your student has had exposure to anyone with COVID within the last 14 days or has run a fever in the last 48 hours, please have them stay home.

What does your worship smell like?

Then Mary took a pound of very costly oil of spikenard, anointed the feet of Jesus and wiped His feet with her hair. And the house was filled with the fragrance of the oil. John 12:3 (NKJV)

The scene in John 12 consisted of a dinner where there was Mary. Mary took a pound of very expensive oil extracted from a plant grown in India and poured it all over Jesus' feet. She then began wiping His feet with her hair. It was a beautiful scene, but you could have cut the tension in the room with a knife. Martha was busying herself and not engaged in the worship. One of the disciples, Judas Iscariot, was questioning Mary's motive. And then there was Jesus with an opportunity to use this sacrifice to bring Himself glory. It is so cool how Jesus put everything in perspective. After being questioned by Judas about the financial aspect of the offering and knowing that He would soon be betrayed by Judas, Jesus took that question and said, "For the poor you have with you always but Me you do not have always."

We can take many things from this encounter. First, don't get so busy that you forget to worship the Lord. We spend so much time in ministry preparing for the work of the Lord that sometimes we forget to do that for which we are preparing. Worship the Lord!

Second, we need to offer our best to the Lord every day. Does our worship have an aroma like the finest of perfumes or does it have a scent that is not so sacrificial? Make every effort to offer your best to the Lord at all times in everything you do. And finally, don't miss any opportunity to worship your Savior. Don't let public opinion sway you from what God has created you to do. There are so many times when you may think to yourself, "What are others going to think of my worship?" Do yourself and the Lord a favor by only concentrating on what pleases God and not what pleases man.
