I. A sad song - Lam 3:19-20

- · The reality of the need for grief.
- · Grief isn't a destination.

II. God's faithful promises can meet every need - v. 21-25

- HOPE for the future v. 21
- LOVE for the present v. 22
- MERCY for my mistakes v. 23
- FAITHFULNESS to sustain me v. 23
 - · Because God is faithful, I can afford confidence when I pray.
 - Because God is faithful, I can conquer <u>evil</u> and <u>temptation</u>. They don't have to hold me down.
 - Because God is faithful, I can <u>praise</u> Him! As long as he's given me life, I have the opportunity to do what even angels cannot – offer him chosen praise.
 - Because God is faithful, we can have courage when fear comes to call.
