IMPORTANT:

Grace and Peace in Christ our Lord today. Let me begin by saying thank you for your willingness to go with us on this strange journey called COVID. The wonderful grace of Jesus will carry us through this and we can be certain He hasn't changed (Heb 13:8) nor has He abandoned us (Heb 13:5). My prayer is that, like Ephesians 6 tells us, we'll stand firm in our conviction on these two matters and walk with the Lord through this AND that we'll do so together.

The changes you'll find below are painful for me personally. The holiday season has (and will!) always be my favorite time of the year, primarily because of the chance to celebrate Christ's arrival, to connect with people, to share a loving meal and a kind word. While we can certainly still celebrate Christ's incarnation, for this year, COVID demands we'll have to make difficult alterations to our plans. These were not made haphazardly. Rather, with a passion for Christ, our Gospel mandate and our desire to shepherd and protect God's people, we've changed our plans. Thus, approved and endorsed by our Church Council at their meeting on November 16th, we've made the following changes to our plans for the remainder of 2020.

THANKSGIVING DINNER

Our plans for Nov 22 were to have our customary First Family Thanksgiving dinner shared together in our Fellowship Hall. However, with the realities we are currently facing, we've decided to dismiss this meal for this year.

WEDNESDAY EVENING MEALS

Wednesday, Nov 18, will be our last "normal" Wednesday schedule. For this Wednesday, Nov 18th, our Wednesday evening schedule will continue as planned with RAs, GAs, Mission friends, Children's choirs, orchestra rehearsal and choir rehearsal. However, on Dec 2, each of these ministries will conclude their semester, two weeks ahead of when we would normally conclude for the year.

CHOIR CHRISTMAS PRESENTATION

Our Choir Christmas presentation, planned for Dec 13, will continue as planned for 6 PM. However, in the interest of protecting the First Family from the most dangerous means of transmitting the virus – singing – we'll hold this as a virtual event. Our choir will record this prior to Dec 13. If you'd prefer a DVD to our online broadcast, please call my office to make that request and we'll get that to you.

A CHANGE OF SCHEDULE FOR THE FINAL TWO SUNDAYS OF 2020 AND THE FIRST SUNDAY OF 2021

For the last two Sundays of 2020 and the first Sunday of 2021, we'll alter our worship and Sunday School schedules. Please stay tuned for those changes in the coming weeks.

CHRISTMAS EVE SERVICES

One Christmas Eve candlelight service will be offered at 4 PM. Given our desire to keep it small and socially distanced, we'll invite you to register for the service if you intend to join us in person. Registration for that service will open on Dec 1. Our Candlelight service will be livestreamed and broadcast on local TV if you'd rather observe the occasion at home.

SOME GOOD NEWS

I got an interesting email recently and I thought the news it contained was worth sharing. The email came from the descendants of Rev GHM Wilson, pastor of FBC Midland from 1894-1895, our 3rd pastor. They were emailing to ask if we would like to have his Bible and a photograph of Rev Wilson and his wife, her hand delicately placed on the Bible in question. Immediately, I said of course! In the days to come, we can look forward to receiving this part of our history and placing it in the Atrium, adjacent to our fellowship hall on our north end. As I thought about it, I reflected on the incredible change Midland has seen since he was our pastor. He was here before Santa Rita #1 – when we were still mostly a railroad town. He was here before the Spanish-American war in 1898, before WWI or WWII. Before cars and telephones were ubiquitous and only 30 years removed from the Civil War. Our church has been through so much and found God to be faithful at every step. We can be certain our God will guide us through this season too. May God's kindness and mercy sustain us today and everyday.

COVID19 - GIVE THANKS IN ALL...

I want to share some good news! Can't we use some? Sometimes it's helpful to take a step back and get a different perspective especially when facing difficult circumstances. We have much to be thankful for as we close the books on a financial year and a difficult season for our community.

We offer thanks:

- First, between March 1st and September 30th (7 months), our FirstCares (Benevolence) ministry helped 129 households with \$123,246 of rent/mortgage assistance for a total of 255 households and \$191,420 for all assistance during the budget year.
- Second, we provided housing for missionaries coming home from overseas, partners traveling through Midland, and a refugee family from South Asia in our Mission Houses.
- Third, we were able to fulfill our financial commitments to our budget partners during this season from caring for those in need in our community, planting Roots Community Church in Seattle, helping pastors along the border and interior Mexico minister during difficult Covid19 conditions, to printing Bibles in Vietnam.
- Fourth, we encouraged and discipled those in prison. Our prison bible correspondence ministry has continued, maybe when it was needed the most!

Because of our budget surplus last year, we were also able to generously support our local partners who have worked so hard under difficult conditions as they fed, clothed, and supported those in need in our community:

- \$84,000 to retire \$8.4 million in medical debt of those in Midland County.
- \$50,000 to Fields' Edge to help build a permanent, supportive, tiny-home community for the chronically homeless in Midland, Texas.
- \$120,000 to partners feeding people in our community: Midland Baptist Crisis Center, Midland Soup Kitchen, Breaking Bread, West Texas Food Bank, and Mission Agape.
- \$25,829 to feed, clothe, and protect children in our community.

May God allow our church family to continue sharing the love of Christ with people in our community and around the world during this difficult season.


