- I. Jesus' description to the Faithful church at Philadelphia 3:7
  - Jesus is Holy and True!
  - Jesus has the Keys!
- II. Jesus' praise for Philadelphia 3:8-11
  - ·Jesus praises them for:
    - Using their open door of evangelism and missions by keeping His word.
