– From the Pastor

Dear First Family,

Grace and Peace to each of us and to our entire Permian family. This weekend was unlike any we've ever known here. The uncertainty and fear that the events of Saturday brought to all of us has stained us. And yet, it is exactly what Jesus told us it would be in John 10:10 – "The Thief comes to steal, kill and destroy but I have come that you might have life and have it abundantly." This is the essence of our confidence – that our God stands supremely over all, even life and death. When you pray this week, pray for the families of the victims. When you pray, ask God to grant healing and peace to all of us who love and live in the Permian. This is our home.

The harsh reality in tragedy is the unending question of why God did not stop this. There will be those for whom this will create a lifetime of bitterness toward God and anger toward him for his perceived apathy. I beg of you to stand clear of that. Don't allow this moment to create a hardness of heart in you toward God. While there can be no doubt this tragedy has changed us, it doesn't have to destroy us. Instead of bitterness, ask God to grant you eyes to see His hand and how you can serve through this. Hold firmly to 2 Corinthians 4:16-18 "Therefore we do not lose heart. Though outwardly we are wasting away, yet inwardly we are being renewed day by day. For our light and momentary troubles are achieving for us an eternal glory that far outweighs them all. So we fix our eyes not on what is seen, but on what is unseen. For what is seen is temporary, but what is unseen is eternal."

Another harsh truth is that life continues, even in this moment of tragedy. With confidence in a God bigger than our grief, we move forward. Our confidence is firmly rooted in Jesus' promise to Lazarus' family in John 11 – "I am the resurrection and the life." Trust Jesus for that today!
