and helps churches and their leaders, as we print and distribute NVB Scripture for Vietnam, under his leadership. Bill chairs our Publication Committee and is our representative in Vietnam. He oversees all of our printing and distribution, going in and out of Vietnam to do so. As a Christian businessman in Midland/Dallas, Bill juggles a myriad of business and VBI matters. Ask the Lord to overshadow his beautiful family; his wife, Mary Jane, and their three children.

- 2. For Dr. Dao Tran and his wife as they face the trials of aging. His wife, Diane, will soon need knee surgery and has back problems. Dao develops all our training curriculum for churches and pastors who use the New Vietnamese Bible. He also oversees and approves all the final texts of NVB Scripture to be printed in Vietnam. He leads pastoral training in Vietnam, through the Vietnamese Baptist Theological College.
- 3. For Evaughn and me as we undergird the work that VBI must do and to assist them in every way needed. We are facing aging and health problems, but the Lord has called us to this ministry.
- 4. For Bill Holmes, me and the VBI Board of Directors, whom God has called into this ministry for the glory of Christ in Vietnam.
