THE FIRST FAMILY IN GUATEMALA

This week has been a remarkable one for several of our members. On Saturday of last week, a crew from the First Family went to Guatemala to serve the people there with water wells! Please pray for their trip and the people they served!

THE BANNER

Recently, my assistant, Susan Upham, brought me a bound edition of some of our *Banner* newsletters from the 1940s. I was impressed by narratives and story telling that was included. Certainly there were announcements, but not nearly as many as we're using now. Beginning March 1, we're going to experiment with some changes to *The Banner*. (1) The one you're likely to notice first is frequency. We'd like to experiment with printing it every other week instead of every week. (2) We'd like to experiment with its content, focusing on the relationships that make FBC a family!

PONDERING....

If you're reading along with me on our "Seeing Clearly" plan, you've just finished reading Exodus 4-6. Right at the end of Chapter 5, there's a part I've missed. Maybe you did, too. Moses is finally willing to be obedient to the Lord and thus goes to Pharoah. Moses clearly believed that if he were obedient to God's directive, things would improve. Things didn't. In fact, they got WORSE! Much worse! At the end of Chapter 5, Moses lays out his complaint to the Lord declaring his frustration! When you read chapter 6, however, you find the Lord's response. And it's filled with promises based on his character. Moses doesn't let a momentary lapse in his walk define his future. God doesn't hold it

When I read it, it occurs to me that sometimes our obedience is measured by our willingness to keep trusting the Lord and keep walking in spite of difficulty or pain.
