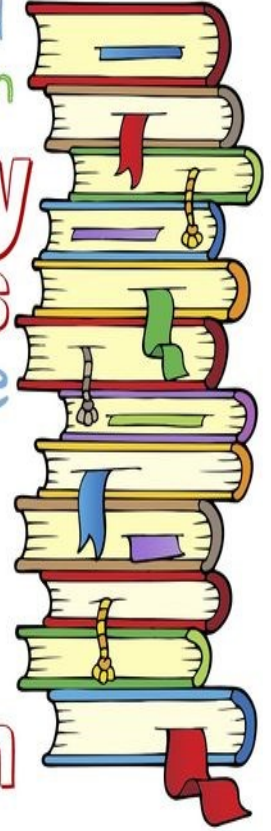


Points Lowdown
