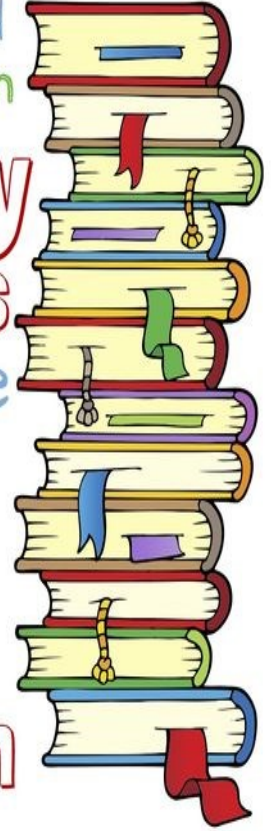


Points Lowdown
