Walking a Life of Purity – Pt 2 – 1 Thess 4:9-12

I. MY HIGHEST EXPRESSION OF LOVING CHRIST IS BY LOVING OTHERS - V. 9-10

- Love GIVEN reveals love RECEIVED.
- The paradox of gaining by giving – The multiplication factor.

TAKE IT HOME:

Loving people is a messy affair, but Jesus died for those difficult and messy people.
Listening to others is the beginning of loving them.

II. WALK PROPERLY BEFORE GOD AND HUMANITY – V. 11-12

- Live quietly
- Mind your own affairs
- Work with your hands. –When we work, we can:
 1. Provide for our families – 1 Tim 5:8.
 2. Provide for those in need – Eph 4:28.
 3. Provide for our own needs – 2 Thess 3:10.
- Honor God with the gifts he's given us. – Gen 3:17; Romans 12
- Declare your dependence! – v. 12
