**TO BECOME MORE LIKE JESUS, I MUST BECOME LESS LIKE ME.
That begins with my thoughts and correcting my worldview.**

I. How do I know what my worldview is? Four questions help reveal it:

- What stories do I listen to?
- What symbols do I identify with?
- What are my habits? And which of them need to change?
- When questions arise, who is my authority?

II. II. I'LL LET JESUS ESTABLISH MY WORLDVIEW! How?

- First, I'll repent from my broken ways of thinking
- Second, I'll shelter my mind.
- Third, I'll renew my mind.
- Fourth, I'll rebuild my mind.

III. III. How I can establishing a Christ-Centered worldview:

- I'll listen to God's stories and let them set the narrative of my life.
- The markers of my life will be shaped by Christ, not merely my preferences.
- I'll let my habits be shaped and changed by Christ.
- Christ is my ONLY authority! His word is the final word!
